

# BARBERSHOP CHORD SPELLER

If the chord you're trying to identify isn't listed below, check the "spelling" to see if an enharmonic equivalent creates a chord. For example, C-D#-G should be spelled C-Eb-G to correctly notate it as a C minor chord. Sometimes chords are intentionally misspelled to make music reading easier for the singer, but correct spelling of a chord gives better information about how to tune it.

\*Diminished 7th and augmented chords are known as symmetrical chords because they are constructed with equal intervals. The diminished 7th chord's tones are all a minor third apart; the augmented chord's tones are all a major third apart. This means that the letter names used to spell the chords should all be labeled as thirds (C,Eb,Gb - not C,Eb,F#). In older arrangements, the diminished 7th chords are sometimes misspelled to avoid double flats on the sheet music. However, we should now strive to spell all chords correctly.
